Mr. McGlashan led the Marin County, California effort to adopt [Marin Clean Energy](#). MCE is a joint power authority designed to serve the *community's priorities* by providing 78% of consumer energy from “non-polluting renewable sources.” While avoiding coal and nuclear power, Marin Clean Energy allows electric consumers to choose non-polluting renewable energy, foster development of local green power generation, and protect homes and businesses from uncertain fuel prices.
